Dismissal...

If you carpool

- Stop by the office and pick up an animal sign for the child you are carpooling with. Show both signs when carpooling.

If you do not have a 2 year old... you might not be aware of their dismissal procedure. Please read even if you do not have a 2 year-old

- Our 2's parents pick up BEFORE the rest of the children at 12:05-12:10.
- You may see them park *parallel* to the dismissal line and that is OK because they will be buckled up and out of the way by the time I send out the older children.
- Please DO NOT pull out and drive around anyone in the dismissal line unless you are directed to do so by a Day School staff member.
- I promise the dismissal time WILL get SHORTER as time goes by...especially after our after school classes start ☺. Thank you for your patience!
- PLEASE continue to talk to your child about "what is your animal name"? This will move things along faster as well. The more you mention it...the sooner they will remember it.
